Configuring Phonerlite Softphone As a GCK Internal Extension

Phonerlite is a free SIP softphone which can be installed on any Windows XP or later PC having a mic and speakers. It can be used as an internal extension on a GCK system.

Instructions

- A. Download the latest release version of the softphone from http://phonerlite.de/download en.htm and install.
- B. Run the softphone. It will start at Setup Wizard Screen 1.




Figure 1 - Setup Wizard Screen 1

- 1. Select manual configuration.
- 2. Enter the IP Address of the GCK controller.
- 3. Click the Next button.

C. In will proceed to Setup Wizard Screen 2.

- 1. Enter the user name, here shown as 222.
- 2. Enter the authentication name, here shown as 222.
- 3. Enter the password. 222 was entered here. Phonerlite obscures password data.
- 4. Click the Next button.

D. It will proceed to Setup Wizard Screen 3. Note that "1.2.3.4" was entered as the IP Address of the GCK Controller in Step B.




Figure 3 - Setup Wizard Screen 3

1. Click the Next button.

E. It will proceed to the Phonerlite main screen.




Figure 4 - Phonerlite Main Screen

- 1. Click the Configuration tab.
- 2. Click the Codecs sub-tab.
- 3. Check, uncheck and re-order codecs to form the order shown. The only selected codecs should be the four visible in the listbox in Figure 4.
- 4. Click the save button.
- 5. The red indicator should begin blinking. The text should say "Registering". When the registration process is completed, the red indicator will turn green. The text will say "Registered."
- 6. A call can now be made to the GCK Direct Action or Prompting Extensions. Click the numbers to enter the destination extension. Click the ">" button to dial. Alternatively, number keys on the keyboard and the Enter key may be used.
